Green World Travel's Rabbit and Green Real Estate's friendly gorilla will also be roaming the festival.

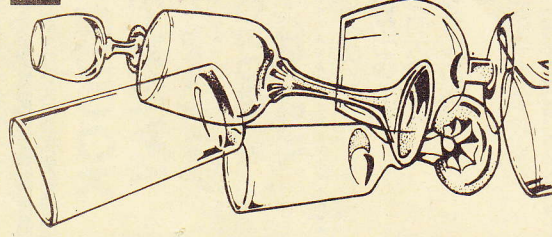
