Sir

Being about erecting a great
number of Houses on the South Head Road
I beg to be favoured with a Grant of the
land, which was I believe originally bro-
t into use by Governor Macquarie to Mr.
Hyatt. — I should also feel much obliged
by having the other two Grants that I ap-
plied for on a former date. The one for
my farm on Lapstone Hill on the Bathurst
Road, and the other for my present
in George Street.

As a number of families
I have no doubt will reside as well as
myself and family on the South Head Road
I wish to have the Grant in my name
if possible — and if I should be invested
with the lease of land which goes
to the sea side I will share it with
the parties living on the Crescent for
their general use.
