

On 28 January, 1941 an Avro Anson Aircraft No. A4-5 of No.1 AIP navigation school RAAF Parkes, crashed on the cnr of Clifton Ave and Lucasville Rd, Glenbrook whilst enroute from Parkes to Mascot on a medical evacuation flight.

All five airmen on board perished in the crash.
